Following the closure of 'Smart Foods', our school has been forced to revisit our bought lunch options for children. After careful consideration we have decided to join the growing list of schools using Lunch-online as our 'bought lunch' provider. Lunch-online lunch items are provided by local company 'Marlow St Pie Kitchen'. The range of options is extensive and menus can be viewed online.

The system for ordering is simple and fully managed by parents (*eliminating child-related forgetfulness*). To find out more or to register your family please visit www.lunchonline.co.nz and locate the options for St Clair School. To help get started, there is a short video on the Lunchonline home page. Click the 'youtube' link.

To use Lunch-online families are required to open an account with an initial \$20 minimum (credit card or bank account transfer options available). Once that is complete, parents are set to order from the menu provided. Healthy and treat options are available with a different set of options on most days.

Our school will be trialing this programme from 11 February. This will allow our families to become familiar with the new internet lunch service before we complete an evaluation in several months.

Lunchonline is also running an introductory promotion – everyone who orders lunch during the first two weeks automatically goes in the draw to win a free lunch. For a further chance to go in the draw, email info@lunchonline.co.nz, and write St Clair School, your student's name, and student's room number in the subject line.

'This lunch service is available Monday to Friday from 11 February.

Orders must be placed by 9.00 am. Late orders cannot be processed by Lunchonline.

Lunches can be ordered several weeks in advance enabling parents with limited internet access to order online using workplace or family computers.
